- The above unaudited standalone and consolidated results of the Company have been been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with rule 3 of the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules 2015 and other relevant amendments thereafter. These financial results have been reviewed and recommended for adoption by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meeting held on 10th August, 2021 by video conferencing. The Statutory Auditors have carried out a limited review of the unaudited standalone and consolidated financial results of the Company for the quarter ended 30th June, 2021, in accordance with Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. The Statutory Auditors have expressed an unmodified review opinion on these results.
- ² The figures of the last quarter of the previous year are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published figures of nine months period end of the previous year.
- Impact of the "second wave" of COVID-19 pandemic has significantly reduced in India. The Government is opening up economic and social activities gradually after the second wave. However, there are significant chances of third wave of COVID-19 pandemic in India based on Government authority's estimation. The Government of India has ruled out a nationwide lockdown for now, but regional lockdowns are implemented in areas with a significant number of cases. Safety of our employees continues to be our key priority. We are encouraging the vaccination of our employees, providing flexible work options and adhering to COVID-19 guidelines. We are closely monitoring the situation and will continue to take all necessary actions to ensure the health and safety of our employees.

The Company has considered the possible effects that may result from COVID-19 in the preparation of these Standalone and Consolidated financial results including the recoverability of carrying amounts of financial and non-financial assets. Based on the current quarter performance and estimates arrived at using external and internal sources of information, the company does not expect any material impact on such carrying values. Given the uncertainty associated with its nature and duration, the impact of COVID-19 on the company's financial statement may differ from that estimated as at the date of approval of standalone and consolidated financial statements and it will continue to monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.

- ⁴ The Code on Social Security 2020, relating to employee benefits during employment and post-employment benefits received the Presidential Assent on September-2020. The Code has been published in the Gazette of India. However, the date on which the Code will come into effect has not yet been notified and final rules / interpretations have not yet been issued. Our conclusion is not modified in respect of this matter.

We did not review the interim financial results of one subsidiary included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial results reflect total revenues of Rs. 1.80 lacs, total net loss after tax of Rs. 0.15 lacs and total comprehensive income of Rs. Nil, for the quarter ended June 2021, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial results have not been reviewed by us. These interim financial results have not been reviewed by other auditors and the unaudited financial statements have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this subsidiary is based solely on the unaudited financial statements furnished to us by Management and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matters.
